

MYRTLE ARNETT

Myrtle Arnett was born to Laura and Oscar W Arnett on Feb 6, 1903/1904 in Ten Sleep, Wyoming (1910 census and find-a-grave site Google the 'Knight report'). Her father was born in Ohio and her mother in Tennessee. Myrtle, Mildred and Marshall (her brother) all lived in Ten Sleep, WY at the time of that census. When she was 7 years old (1911) her mother Laura underwent intestinal surgery which resulted in her death . The three small children (in 1920) were living in Worland, WY with their father Oscar and his 2nd wife, Sarah G Arnett. Their next-door neighbors were the Wostenbergs. Her sister Mildred was married in Douglas, WY (December 1924). At the age of 22, Myrtle Arnett passed away November 8, 1926 in Thermopolis, WY at the Mineral Springs Hotel, Hot Springs Co. (Google search Worland Grit and other). She had not married and left no offspring.

MYRTLE ARNETT DIES AFTER SHORT ILLNESS

Myrtle Arnett, 22 years of age, daughter of O. W. Arnett, passed away Sunday, November 7th, at 12:00 midnight. Myrtle was confined to her bed for only one day and her death came as a great shock to her relatives and host of friends in this section of Wyoming. Miss Arnett was operator for a number of years at the local telephone office and during that time made many friends. Funeral services were conducted yesterday morning at 10:00 o'clock A. M., in the Baptist church, Rev. Clyde Hampton conducting the services. After the services the remains were taken to Ten Sleep where they were laid to rest in the cemetery at that place, along side of her mother.

Miss Arnett passed away at the hospital at Thermopolis from diabetes.

The funeral was attended by a large number of friends and relatives; the floral offerings were beautiful.

Her sister, Mrs. Dull and husband of Dull Center, Wyoming, and Mr. and Mrs. Charles Mitchell of Lovell, cousins, were present at the funeral.
