1917 – 2004

BUFFALO - Services for Buffalo resident Margaret T. Adams, 87, will be conducted at 10 a.m. Wednesday, Nov. 24, at the United Methodist Church of Buffalo by the Rev. Su Dubree. Burial will follow at 2 p.m. in Ten Sleep Cemetery. with the Rev. Sue Carey officiating.

She died Nov. 21, 2004, at Amie Holt Care Center in Buffalo.

Born Jan. 30, 1917, in Buffalo, she was the daughter of Charles and Florence (Holland) Sorensen; and was raised on the family ranch in Spotted Horse. She graduated from high school in Gillette.

She attended Montana State University-Bozeman, then taught at Warner Ranch and Spotted Horse schools.

In 1937, she married James B. Smith in Gillette. The couple later divorced.

She moved to Newcastle in 1944 to work for the Social Security Administration. In 1947, she moved to Casper to work as a secretary for Sacony-Vacuum for a year, then moved to Sheridan to work for an architect.

She married Vern Adams in Sheridan in 1951. They, too, divorced.

In 1952, she went to work for Northern Pacific Transportation in Billings, Mont., and retired in 1972. She also sold NeoLife Products for several years.

She moved to Ten Sleep in 1990 to be near her son; and, in 2001, relocated to Buffalo.

A member of United Methodist Church, she enjoyed sewing, crocheting, collecting antique dishes, reading, and watching professional football on television.

Survivors include her son, Douglas Smith, and his wife of Ten Sleep; daughter, Roxanne Haughey, and her husband of Phoenix; sister-in-law and close companion, Susan Sorensen of Buffalo; three grandchildren; and four great-grandsons.

She was preceded in death by her parents and two brothers, Glenn and Bob Sorenson.
