Marion Charles Anger, 67, died Sunday, April 4, at Washakie Memorial Hospital following a heart attack suffered at his home in Ten Sleep.

He was born April 19, 1914 in Big Rapids, Mich., to Jay W. and Florence Anger. On Jan. 1, 1969 he married Patricia DeVolder in Moline, Ill.

He was raised in Big Rapids, Mich., and following his high school graduation he attended Normal College in Michigan where he obtained his teaching certificate.

He then taught in a rural school for several years and served in the Army during World War II in the Pacific Theater. He then attended Palmer College of Chiropractic in Davenport, Iowa, where he was also a staff instructor for 10 years.

He retired in 1976 after having a private practice in Moline, Ill., for 32 years. His family moved to Ten Sleep in 1976.

He was a member of the International Chiropractic Association; the Methodist Church; the Masonic Lodge 46 A.F. & A. M. in Ten Sleep; and Signal Cliff Chapter 49 O.E.S. in Ten Sleep. He was also a member of the American Legion in Moline, Ill., and a life member of the Disabled American Veterans.

Survivors include his wife, Patricia of Ten Sleep; one son, Jay Anger of the family home in Ten Sleep; three step-sons, Michael DeVolder of Colona, Ill., Larry DeVolder of East Moline, Ill., and Robert DeVolder of Moline, Ill.; one daughter, Mrs. Neil (Barbara) Slezak of Bettendorf, Iowa; two step-daughters, Mrs. Bob (Diane) Ray of Powell and Mrs. Andy (Donna) Williams of Thermopolis; one sister, Reverend Grace Dunn of Big Rapids, Mich., and nine grandchildren.

Funeral service will be at 11 a.m. Thursday, April 8, at the United Methodist Church in Ten Sleep with the Rev. Loy Estes officiating. Burial will be in the Ten Sleep Cemetery with Masonic Lodge 46 providing graveside rites.

The body will lie-in-state all day Wednesday at the Veile Mortuary in Worland and Thursday from 9 a.m. until the service at the Methodist Church in Ten Sleep.
