### Ten Sleep Man

TEN SLEEP — Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. today (Tuesday) in the LDS church here for Alvin O. Apland, 39, of Ten Sleep, who died Friday in St. Vincent's hospital at Billings, Mont.

Bishop Mark Carter will officiate. Burial will be in Ten Sleep cemetery, with military rites. Floyd Minch post 44, American Legion, Worland, will furnish color guard and firing squad. The body will lie in state at the church from 12:30 to 1:30 p.m., at which time the casket will be closed. Veile mortuary of Worland is in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Apland was born Aug. 4, 1929, in Worland, the son of Mr. and Mrs. G. O. Apland. He served in the U.S. Army in Korea from May 1951 until receiving his honorable discharge in 1953. Most of his life was spent in Worland, where he worked as a carpenter.

Mr. Apland married Myrona Allred of Ten Sleep on Feb. 22, 1957, in Worland. They resided in Worland until moving to Ten Sleep five years ago.

Mr. Apland was a member of the Ten Sleep town council, the VFW and Volunteer fire department here.

He is survived by his wife and children, Tammy Sue, Gary Dean and Jere Lee, all of Ten Sleep; his parents and a sister, Mrs. John Dellos, all of Worland, and a brother, Leo Apland of Mvrtle Creek, Ore.
