Gary Blair was born 26 May 1952 to Alma McCreery and Hayden (Pete) Blair. It is believed he was born in Worland, WY. TEN SLEEP — Gary M. Blair died of cancer Thursday at his home west of Ten Sleep. He was 33.

Blair was born May 26, 1952, in Worland, a son of Hayden M. "Pete" and Alma M. (McCreery) Blair.

He moved with his family from Worland to Ten Sleep when he was in first grade and graduated from Ten Sleep High School in 1970. In addition to serving in the Wyoming National Guard, he was a partner with his father in Big Horn Services of Ten Sleep, selling petroleum products and operating a service station.

A member of the Ten Sleep United Methodist Church, he also was active in the Ten Sleep Masonic Lodge, Ten Sleep Merchants Association, Ten Sleep Lions Club and American Legion Post No. 44 in Worland.

Ten Sleep; a sister, Mrs. Grant (Ann) Patik of Buffalo; a niece; and two nephews.

The funeral service will be at 2 p.m. Monday in the Ten Sleep United Methodist Church, with the Rev. Jim Heikes officiating. Burial will be at the Ten Sleep Cemetery with the American Legion and Ten Sleep Masonic Lodge conducting graveside services.
