Funeral Set For Mrs. Bader

Mrs. Ethel Bader, 89, of Ten Sleep, long-time resident of the Big Horn basin, died Wednesday in Washakie Memorial hospital here following a short illness.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Saturday in the Ten Sleep Methodist church, with the Rev. Ronald Lang officiating. Burial will be in Ten Sleep cemetery. Veile mortuary is in charge of arrangements.

Mrs. Bader was born March 14, 1880, in Rensselaer, Ind., the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Paris Daugherty. She attended Normal Training school in Terre Haute, Ind. She came to Otto, Wyo., in 1903 with her parents, and moved to the Nowood area in 1904, where she taught at the Mann school.

On March 28, 1905, she was married to Fred Bader at Ten Sleep and the couple settled in the Nowood river area. Mr. Bader died Dec. 7, 1950. Mrs. Bader had resided in recent years at Ten Sleep.

Surviving are three sons, Fred of Worland, Beryl of Hyattville and Paris of Ten Sleep; three daughters, Mrs. Jack (Vivian) Whaley of Worland, Mrs. Beatrice Berry of Basin and Mrs. Delbert (Maureen) Hollcroft of Buffalo; one sister, Mrs. Earl Allen of Missoula, Mont., 17 grandchildren and 42 great-grandchildren.
