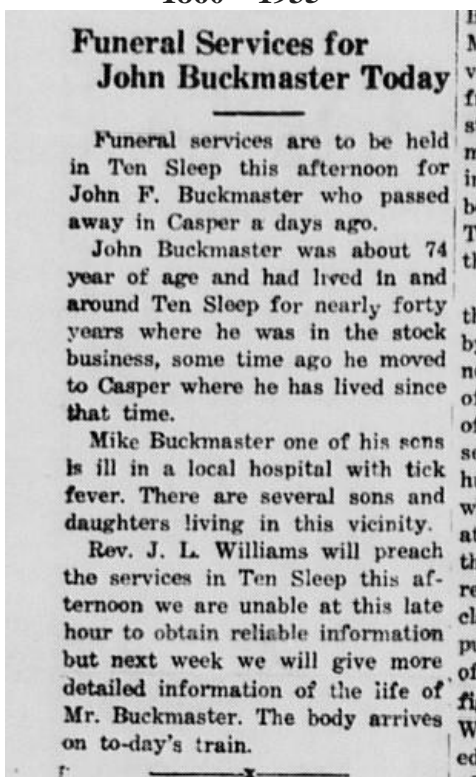

Obituary

John Fletcher Buckmaster, was born, August 12th, 1860 at Elkhart, Indiana, died at Casper, Wyoming, June 18th, 1935.

Widely known throughout the State of Wyoming, where he came in the year of 1860, employed as Bull Whacker, John Buckmaster freighted in and out of Buffalo, Rock Creek and Fort Laramie. He came into the Big Horn Basin country in the year of 1889 locating on Ten Sleep Creek and lived for several years on what is now the Frison ranch.

He was married to Mary Jennings near Buffalo, Wyoming on December 24th, 1885. To this union was born, Fred Roy Buckmaster, of Grand Pass, Oregon, Edith May Buckmaster, Ten Sleep, Wyo. Mike Buckmaster of Ten Sleep, Wyoming, Clara (Topsy) Buckmaster Bull of Ten Sleep, Wyoming.

Mrs. Buckmaster died June 10th 1915, and Edith died in 1908, all the other children live to mourn his loss. His sisters Mrs. Emma Smith of Ten Sleep, Wyoming, and Mrs. Ida Burkheart of Sheridan, Wyoming, as does a brother, Dick Buckmaster, also of Sheridan, Wyoming.

The family moved from Ten Sleep valley in ninety-two to Otter Creek where they made their home for many years. In 1910 they moved to Spring Creek where they lived until 1916 when following Mrs. Buckmaster's death, Mr. Buckmaster moved to Casper
