BABY DIES

Elmer David Calton, small son of Mr. and Mrs. Clay Calton of Ten Sleep passed away at a Worland hospital Tuesday, cause of death being tubercular meningitis. He had been ill but a short time and not thought seriously so.

The little boy was born on the ninth day of February, 1936 and passed away on April 26. being thirteen months and 18 days of age. He leaves to mourn his loss, his parents and two brothers, Calvin and Billie.

Funeral services were held at Ten Sleep yesterday at 2:30, the Rev. D. M. Kitch, officiating.

Elmer David Calton was the third son born to Cal and Alta Arnold Calton. On Earth his sojourn was temporary, but in the hearts of his family he was forever. He joined Calvin and William (Billy) Calton in 1936 and expired in April 1937 (this vital statistic was printed in the Thursday issue (Worland Grit) April 29, 1937).

NOTE: The mother of Elmer David Calton is the daughter of Bert Arnold (the blacksmith in the 1920s and 1930s) and his wife, Mable Jacobs Arnold. Cal Calton spent abt 15 years in the Ten Sleep school system as the Ten Sleep Canyon bus driver and the school janitor. He was superb in both positions. The Caltons were a very nice family. fb
