Gladys L Caudell was the wife of Clyde Clinton Caudell also interred in the Ten Sleep cemetery in the year 1991. She was born the 13 February 1923 (possibly Washington State); received her SS # before 1951 in California and died 17 November 1992 at Newport, Washington, among family and friends. She is listed with Clyde C as a housekeeper and he as a truck driver in Richmond, CA, in the California precinct #7 (1900-1968). Sometime after 1970 they moved to Wyoming and became residents of the Ten Sleep vicinity. In Newport, WA, where she passed away there were Steven L, Agnes L, Heather L and Cindy L Caudell without recorded data naming their relationships to Gladys and Clyde Caudell.
