Mrs. Esther Cogdill (80) passed away after a brief illness. She had been a resident of the Big Horn Basin for about 33 years. Her husband died 14 years earlier. Since that time, Mrs. Cogdill has lived with her son C. F. Cogdill, on his Nowood Ranch. Funeral services were held in the Ten Sleep Methodist Church with Reverend D.[Dwight] M Kitch officiating.

COGDILL RITES TO BE IN TEN SLEEP SUNDAY

Funeral services for Mrs. Esther Cogdill, 20, will be held at the church in Ten Sleep Sunday at 2:30 p. m., with Rev. D. M. Kitch officiating. Burial will be at the Ten Sleep cemetery.

Mrs. Cogdill died Thursday at the Worland Hospital after a brief illness. She entered the hospital Wednesday.

She had been a resident of this section of the Big Horn basin about 33 years. Her husband preceded her in death by 14 years. Since his death, Mrs. Cogdill has been living with her son, C. F. Cogdill, at his ranch on the No-wood.
