## Fern Crall

**WORLAND** — Fern Crall, 88, of Worland, died Friday, Oct. 11, at Poplar Living Center in Casper.

She was born Nov. 24, 1902, in McCook, Neb., a daughter of Thurston and Dora (Little) Doyle. She was raised in McCook and attended school there. She moved with her family to Hyattville about 1920.

In 1924, she married Don Crall in Basin. Following her marriage, she lived in Kansas, Oklahoma and in Dallas. While living in Dallas, she was office manager for Taylor Publishing Co. and also was a real estate agent. She moved to Worland in 1972 after retiring.

Mrs. Crall was a member of the United Methodist Church in Worland and enjoyed babysitting.

Survivors include one son, Russ of Spicewood, Texas; one daughter, Mrs. Marval Harrison of Worland; one brother, Dean Doyle of Hyattville; three sisters, Mrs. Gladys Morrison of Colorado Springs, Mrs. June Gossens of Ten Sleep and Mrs. Darlene Kershner of Bozeman, Mont.; five grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents and one sister, Evelyn Bechtel.

The service is scheduled for 10 a.m. today in the United Methodist Church in Worland, with the Rev. Ted Cox officiating. The casket will be open at the church from 8 to 10 a.m. Burial will be at noon in the Ten Sleep Cemetery.

Fern Doyle was born in Nebraska on 24 November 1902 to Thurston and Dora Doyle. The family grew to have 6 daughters and one son: Dean, Evelyn, June, Darlene, Gladys, Fern and Gayle. In 1921 she held a teaching position in Hyattville, WY where her family had moved when they left Nebraska. She married ca 1927 Donald H Crall and the couple had one son, Russell D Crall. Data are scant on Fern Crall's long life but she was living in Moran, Shackleford, TX in 1930 and later was in Worland (U.S. Directory for Cities: address Howell Street). The Doyle family were well known in the Big Horn Basin including Ten Sleep. Her sister June Doyle Gossens was a long-time resident in Ten Sleep. She passed away on October 11, 1991.
