Mrs. Daugherty spent many days in the Worland hospital after the accident while doctors held little hope for her life. However, with unusual vigor she was able to return to her home though she remained in bed and was nursed constantly.

She was injured when the automobile in which her husband and a granddaughter, Esther Daugherty, were riding left the highway and overturned several times as the three were en route home from Worland on the afternoon of June 14.

Mrs. Daugherty and her husband, residents of the Ten Sleep country for the past 40 years, own and operate the Conoco Service station at Ten Sleep and the tourist camp in connection. They recently celebrated their 62nd wedding anniversary.
