CHEYENNE — Stephanie E. Day, 31, formerly of Worland, died Saturday, Feb. 1, in Cheyenne following a car accident.

She was born Feb. 1, 1961, in Wheatland, a daughter of Lester E. and Bonnie L. (Collins) Day. She was raised in Wheatland and moved to Ten Sleep in 1973.

The family then lived in Greybull and Basin before moving back to Ten Sleep.

She moved to Cheyenne in 1986 and attended Laramie County Community College for three years.

Miss Day was employed as a part-time data entry clerk for Blue Cross and Blue Shield at the time of her death.

Survivors include her mother of Denver; one son, Brandon Day of Cheyenne; one daughter, Allison Day of Cheyenne; three brothers, Lane Day of Cody, Randy Van Ortwick of Cheyenne and Wes Van Ortwick of Ten Sleep and four sisters, Nerissa Nickerson of Golden, Colo. and Lela Logan, Jolene Day and Rhonda Jordan, all of Worland.

Graveside service is scheduled for 2 p.m. Thursday in the Ten Sleep Cemetery, with the Rev. Lonnie Liebelt of the Seventh Day Adventist Church officiating.

Veile Mortuary of Worland is in charge of arrangements.

Stephanie E Day was born on February 1, 1961 to Lester and Bonnie Day. In addition to Stephanie, Bonnie and Lester were parents to one son, Lane and three other daughters - Lela, Rhonda, and Bertha (Jolene). There were also three half-siblings in the family – Wesley, Randy and Nerissa.
