

## Norman Arthur Devereaux 1943-2002

The newspaper clipping indicating an obituary for Norman Arthur Devereaux appeared in the Lovell Newspaper 14 May 2002. He was apparently the son of Arthur (Lawrence A ) Devereaux born on 8 June 1943.. By the time the Vietnam War rolled around, he was in his mid-twenties and he joined the U.S. Army as SP4 and served in Vietnam with military troops. Records show he lived in Boise, Idaho and in Worland, Wyoming on Big Horn Avenue, no other public record could be definitely pertinent to this particular individual. He died May 10, 2002 and his gravesite has a military monument to his service to his country.

WORLAND — Norman Arthur Devereaux, 58, died Friday, May 10 at his home in Worland.

Cremation will take place. The family will hold a memorial service this coming summer in the Big Horn Mountains.

Norman was born June 8, 1943 in Lovell to Lawrence Arthur "Art" and Vernice M. (Pepper) Devereaux. Norman lived at

Greybull until 1949 when the family moved to Worland where he attended schools and graduated from Worland High School in 1962.

He joined the U.S. Army in 1965 and served in Germany. Following his discharge in 1967, he returned to Worland and worked for various firms including Totem Construction, John Dent Ranch, Western Air Drilling, DM Consulting, Swing Trucking, L.S.I. and Fremont Beverages.

He married JoEllen Cook on Oct. 20, 1967 at Worland. They were later divorced.

He eventually moved to Idaho where he drove truck for Eddy's Bakery and for an asphalt paving company.

Norman enjoyed fishing, hunting and visiting with friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

Norman is survived by one son, Tony (Mysty) Devereaux of Casper and their daughter Shayna; two daughters, Tanya (Brad) Hughes of Casper and Courtney Devereaux of Billings, Mont.; one brother, Richard (June) Devereaux of Casper; and one sister, Natalie (Jerry) Shryack of Worland.

A private family viewing was held on Sunday at the funeral home.
