**Mrs. Jack Dunham of  
Ten Sleep Passes Away**

Death claimed Mrs. Della Dunham of Ten Sleep Monday, October 13th bringing the second bereavement to the family within a few weeks, her mother, Mrs. Mark H. Warner having preceded her in death on Sept. 29th.

Mrs. Dunham was a typical pioneer woman having come to the Big Horn Basin in the early days and grew up with the new country. She was one of the first to take up a homestead on the mountains and for many years her claim was a land mark for the country side.

Funeral services were held on Wednesday, October 15th at Ten Sleep, Rev. Jno. Frank Smith officiating and interment had at the Ten Sleep Community Cemetery.

Della D. Warner was born at Red Cloud, Nebraska, December 8th, 1879, the daughter of Mark H. and Sara (Munsell) Warner. She resided at Red Cloud until April, 1893 when the family moved to Wyoming where she has made her home ever since.

She was married to Mr. Jack Dunham on December 26th, 1918 and is survived by her husband, her father, two brothers Laird and Berch, and two sisters, Mrs. Frances Sutherland and Mrs. John Richardson.
