## **E. C. Edwards Dies of Spotted Fever**

Edward C. Edwards passed away at a local hospital Monday morning, June 4th, the cause of his death being Spotted or Tick fever. He took ill in his home above Ten Sleep and had been brought over here only a few days before his death.

Edward C. Edwards was 71 years of age, was born in Bates County, Missouri, and had lived in the Ten Sleep vicinity for the past six years, for some time past he had been living in a cabin on the Billie Miles place near the Buttes about thirteen miles above Ten Sleep. For several years Mr. and Mrs. Edwards lived in what is known as the Arnott cabin about a mile above the Ten Sleep Ranger Station; he will be remembered by many who spent some time in the mountains and by the workmen in the timber.

Mr. Edwards leaves one son, Henry Edwards of Gillette, and his wife Maude Edwards.

Funeral services will be held this afternoon at the Ten Sleep cemetery with Rev. Williams of the M. E. Church officiating.

Mrs. Edwards expects to go to Burlington, Wyoming where she will live with a son, George MacFarland.
