TEN SLEEP — Eula E. Egbert, a longtime Ten Sleep resident, died Tuesday, Aug. 6, at the Wyoming Retirement Center in Basin. She was 86.

She was born on Spring Creek, south of Ten Sleep, on Sept. 2, 1898, a daughter of Robert A. and Eva (Tull) Wain.

On January 26, 1917, she married Brooks Egbert at Worland.

She was raised and schooled in the Ten Sleep area and had lived on the family ranch for nearly 60 years in the Spring Creek-Otter Creek area. The family moved to Ten Sleep where Mrs. Egbert was the "First Lady" for 12 years while her husband was mayor of Ten Sleep.

He preceded her in death in 1973.

Mrs. Egbert was a member of the Ten Sleep Methodist Church, the Order of Eastern Star and the Jolly Neighbors.

She is survived by a son, Larry, of Ten Sleep; by three daughters, Mrs. Loyd (Marjory) Woody of Riverton, Mrs. Wes (Grace) O'Neill of Dixon,

Calif. and Mrs. Wyman (Bernice) Augustin of Davis, Calif.; and by 16 grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Egbert was preceded in death by two sons, Robert and Ernest, and a grandson, Phillip.

The funeral will be at 11 a.m. Saturday at the Ten Sleep Methodist Church, Rev. R. James Heikes officiating. Burial will be in Ten Sleep Cemetery.
