Funeral services for Mrs. Mellie M. Emery were conducted at the Methodist church in Ten Sleep Thursday. Mrs. Emery died at the home of her son-in-law and daughter.

She was born May 16, 1868, in Lemonware, Wis. After finishing her schooling she joined her parents in Nebraska where she taught school for six years.

She returned to Wisconsin and on Oct. 10, 1891, was married to Burdette D. Emery. Three daughters were born to this union, one of whom, Mrs. Charles Ford, survives.

In 1897 Emery and family came to Wyoming settling at Ten Sleep where he homesteaded.
