## Arthur P. Evans

Arthur Paul Evans of Ten Sleep died Thursday, Feb. 15 at Washakie Memorial Hospital after suffering a stroke in his home. He was 69.

He was born Sept. 7, 1920 in Ft. Smith, Ark., the son of William Arthur and Dicy Faye (Roberts) Evans. He grew up in Avenal, Calif. and graduated from high school there.

He served in the U.S. military during the European conflict.

In 1948, he married Wanda Barlow. They were later divorced. On March 5, 1960, he married Dorothy Marie Cheeney in Bell Gardens, Calif.

The couple moved to Ten Sleep in 1983 after he retired from Lockheed Aircraft Corp. where he worked as an aircraft structures mechanic.

He was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and the Ten-Sleep Senior Citizens. His hobbies included the outdoors, hunting, fishing, guns and reloading and reciting poetry.

Survivors include his wife of Ten Sleep; one son, Stephen Paul of Los Angeles; two daughters, Mrs. David (Paulette) Michaels of Lancaster, Calif. and Mrs. Chris (Carol Ann)

Christensen of Van Nuys, Calif.; one sister, Mrs. Walter (Juanita) McCaleb of Rochester, Minn.; three grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

The service is scheduled for 2 p.m. Monday in the Ten Sleep LDS Church, with the Rev. John Folsom officiating. Burial will be in Ten Sleep Cemetery.

Arthur P Evans was born 7 September 1920 in Sebastian, USA to Cornelius E and wife Susan Evans. According to 1920 U.S. Census the family were living in Ft Bridger, Wyoming.

The Evans family had a nephew Raymond living with them and several siblings: Edward, Henry, Grant, Harold, and Wanda. In 1930, the family were in Uinta County at Sulphur Springs. At this time, they appear to have another nephew and a couple of nieces living with them and they own their ranch. He was a private in the US Army during WW II. He died February 15, 1990.

Postscript: Data was scanty on Mr. Evans. It would be good to have a newspaper clipping. Both parents were from Rich County, Utah prior to moving into Uinta County, Wyoming. The parents were married in 1898.
