George Ferguson Dies Sunday in Ten Sleep Home

TEN SLEEP — George Walker Ferguson, retired attorney, died of a heart attack in his home in Ten Sleep Sunday.

He was born March 25, 1875, in Lobelville, Tenn., son of Mr. and Mrs. George W. Ferguson. He spent his childhood there. He served in the Spanish American war in 1898 and 1899.

Mr. Ferguson received his bachelor of arts degree from Grandview college, Tex., and his Doctor of Law degree from Cumberland university, Lebanon, Tenn. He began his law practice in Watonga, Okla. He was appointed postmaster of Watonga in 1906 and served two years as county judge of Blaine county, Okla.

He was married to Pearl White of Canton, Okla., in 1908. The couple moved to Casper in 1913. He retired from active practice in 1947 when he moved to Worland. He moved to Ten Sleep later.

Mr. Ferguson was a member of the Methodist church and served twice as a lay delegate to general conferences—once from Oklahoma and once from Wyoming.

He served as president of the Wyoming Spanish American War Veterans and assistant attorney general of Wyoming. He received an honorary plaque from the Wyoming Bar association for 50 years of service. He was a member of the Masonic lodge, Cloud Peak Chapter 27.

Survivors include his widow, a daughter, Mrs. Grace Ferguson Staley, Millbrae, Calif., a son, George W. Ferguson, IV, Saratoga, Calif., and four grandchildren and one great grandson.

Funeral services will be held at the Ten Sleep Methodist church at 2 p.m. Wednesday with the Rev. Howard Kildow, pastor, officiating. Burial will be in the Ten Sleep cemetery.
