Pearl W. Ferguson, 89, of Ten Sleep died Saturday at Washakie Memorial Hospital. She was born June 16, 1883, in West Liberty, Iowa, the daughter of Byron E. and Olive B. White. She married George Ferguson Jr., Aug. 20, 1908, in Cantonment, Okla.

The couple moved to Casper in 1913 and to Worland in 1947 where he practiced law. Following Mr. Ferguson's retirement in 1957, the couple moved to Ten Sleep. Mrs. Ferguson was a member of the United Methodist Church, a past member of the Order of Eastern Star, past state president and member of the Women's Christian Temperance Union, had taught the Pearl Philathea Sunday school in Casper for 34 years and was the Sunday school superintendent of the Ten Sleep United Methodist Church until a few years ago.

Survivors include the widower; a daughter, Mrs. Grace Staley of Millbrae, Calif.; a sister, Mrs. Edna Breeden of Ten Sleep; four grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be 1 p.m. Wednesday at the Ten Sleep United Methodist Church with the Rev. Billy Bowden officiating. Burial will follow in the Ten Sleep Cemetery under the direction of the Veile Mortuary.
