FORT LARAMIE --- Robert David Breeden, 68, formerly of Ten Sleep, died Wednesday, March 30, in his home in Fort Laramie following a long illness.

He was born Sept. 22, 1925 in Casper, a son of David and Martha (White) Breeden. He grew up on a ranch near Ten Sleep.

From 1943 to 1946, he served in the U.S. Navy. He later ranched on the family ranch for a time.

On Sept. 29, 1946, he married Betty Jane Drake in Billings, Mont.

He ranched out of Lovell for the C. A. Lewis estate near Cowley. The family later made its home in Fort Laramie where he ranched for Marrie Schissler Blocker. He retired in 1990.

Mr. Breeden was a member of American Legion Post No. 17 in Cheyenne. He served as sexton of the Fort Laramie Cemetery from 1986 to 1989.

Survivors include his wife of Fort Laramie; two sons, David E. of Fort Laramie and Raymond D. of Rapid City, S. D.; one daughter, Charlotte Sue Jacobs of Norfolk, Va.; one brother, Byron E. of Ten Sleep, two sisters, Elizabeth Bader and Mayme Bader, both of Ten Sleep; and seven grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents and his twin brother, Ralph.

Memorial service is scheduled for 1 p.m. Saturday in the Fort Laramie Presbyterian Church, with the Rev. Thomas Lineweaver officiating. Burial will take place at a later date in Ten Sleep.
