**ERNEST R EGBERT FUNERAL TONIGHT**

Visitation and services for Ernest R Egbert, 49, who died Thursday at Bassett Army Hospital, will be held tonight at the Chapel of Christ.

Visitation will be from 3 to 6 p.m. and Masonic Services at 8 p.m.

Ernest was the son of Brooks Egbert and Eula Waln of Ten Sleep.

Egbert is survived by his wife, Lucy, daughters Kathleen Andromia and Theresa Egbert and his mother, Eula.

Egbert served as a management analyst to the Government at the time of his death. He will be interred in Wyoming.

Note: this article indicates that Ernest R. Egbert was 49 years old in 1975, making his birth year 1926 or 1927. His headstone records his birth year as 1928.

Ernest R. Egbert, 47, a native of Ten Sleep, died May 15 at the Bassett Army hospital in Fort Wainwright, Alaska.

Egbert was born Jan. 26, 1928, in Ten Sleep, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Brooks Egbert.

He was married May 3, 1950 to Lucy Peterson at Pavillion. He was raised in Ten Sleep and joined the U.S. Air Force in 1946 and retired in Aug. 1968.

Since then he has worked for the Army as a management analyst at Fort Wainwright, Alaska.

He was a member of the Ten Sleep Masonic Lodge No. 46, the Al Aska Shrine Temple in Anchorage, Alaska, and the Farthest North Shrine Temple in Fairbanks, Alaska.

He is survived by his widow; his mother, Mrs. Brooks Egbert, Ten Sleep; two daughters, Mrs. John A. (Kathleen) Andronico, Las Vegas, Nev., and Theresa Egbert, Fairbanks; two brothers, Robert Egbert, Hanover, Ill., and Larry Egbert, Ten Sleep; and three sisters, Mrs. Loyd (Marjorie) Woody, Riverton, Mrs. Wyman (Bernice) Augustine, Davis, Calif., and Mrs. Wesley (Grace) O'Neil, Dixon, Calif.

Funeral services will be Thursday at 2 p.m. at the Ten Sleep Methodist Church with the Rev. Billy Bowden officiating. Burial will be in Ten Sleep Cemetery. American Legion Post No. 44 will conduct graveside rites.
