TEN SLEEP — Funeral services for Blanche E. Ford, 85, will be Friday at 2 p.m. at the Ten Sleep Methodist Church with the Rev. James Dickinson of Buffalo and the Rev. Ruth Wight of Ten Sleep officiating. Mrs. Ford died Tuesday at the Soldiers and Sailors Home in Buffalo.

She was born Aug. 4, 1892 at Elroy, Wis. the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Burdette Emery. She moved to Ten Sleep with her parents when she was four-years-old. She attended grade school in Ten Sleep and graduated from high school in Basin.

She attended summer sessions at the University of Wyoming to obtain her teaching certificate. She taught school in Ten Sleep for six years and at the Bader School for five years. She was postmaster in Ten Sleep for 12 years.

She married Charles H. Ford on June 6, 1917 at Ten Sleep. She was a member of the Ten Sleep Methodist Church and the Signal Cliff Chapter O.E.S. in Ten Sleep.

She is survived by her husband; a niece, Mrs. Marcella Chamberline of Pasadena, Calif. and one nephew, Gerald Frison of Dana Point, Calif. She was preceded in death by one daughter.

Mrs. Ford moved from her life-long home in Ten Sleep to Buffalo in October of 1974. She and her husband celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary in June of this year.

Burial will be in the Ten Sleep Cemetery with Veile Mortuary in charge of arrangements.
