Small Foreman Boy Drowned Near Tensleep

William Elmer Foreman was born at Ten Sleep, Wyoming, Feb. 17th, 1934 and died August 22, 1935. Aged 1 year, 7 months and 5 days.

He was the only child of Ernest and Doraine Foreman. Besides his parents he is survived by one grandfather, Elmer Foreman of Big Trails, Wyoming and one grandmother, Mrs. Aadne Skrettinglond of Ten Sleep and three aunts and five uncles.

The little 17 month old baby of Mr. and Mrs. Ernest Foreman was drowned in the Victoria Ditch at Ten Sleep last Thursday evening. The child had been playing in the garden and for a few moments was alone and he fell into the canal, the canal crosses the end of the garden.

A search for the boy was started as soon as he was missed but when he was found after a short time every effort was used to bring the little fellow back to life but to no avail. Dr. Robert McKenn made the trip to Ten Sleep in record time but could do nothing. Artificial respiration was used my a tourist before the Doctor arrived.

Funeral services were held in Basin.
