Earl Clarence Glanville, 73, died Saturday at Ivinson Memorial Hospital in Laramie. He was born Mar. 3, 1900, in Beulah, Wyo., the son of Clarence and Helena Glanville. He married Carol Lorenz Oct. 15, 1920 in Billings.

Mr. Glanville was a former steel worker and a 25-year employe of the Wyoming Highway Department. He had lived in Worland and Ten Sleep before retiring in 1966. He later spent the winters in Mesa, Ariz. He had served in the U.S. Navy during World War I and was a member of the Methodist Church and VFW Post No. 2281 of Thermopolis.

Survivors include the widow; a daughter, Mrs. George C. Frison of Laramie; and one granddaughter. He was preceded in death by a son, William.

Following the cremation, Mr. Glanville's ashes will be buried in the Ten Sleep Cemetery.
