## **OLD TIMER OF TEN SLEEP DIES**

Jacob Ellsworth Goodrich, an early day resident of Ten Sleep, died at a Thermopola hospital early this morning after a short illness. Born 54 years ago in Missouri, he early left Missouri and moved to Colorado. In 1890 he came to Wyoming, settling in the Ten Sleep country, where he has lived since. He is survived by his wife, Louisa; three sons, James, William and Jacob; and a step-daughter, Mrs. Myrtle Godfrey of Ten Sleep. Two brothers, William D., of Denver and Robert, of Ten Sleep, who was at his bedside during his illness here; three sisters, Mrs. Stella Henry, and Mrs. Mable Orchard of Denver, and Mrs. Cora Crowley of Lander, and his mother, Mrs. Maratha E. Childs of Denver also survive. Mrs. Emma Thoren of Thermopola is a niece.
