TEN SLEEP — Funeral services for E. Oneta Greet, 71, of Ten Sleep will be held Saturday, Nov. 30 at 10 a.m. at the United Methodist Church in Ten Sleep with Christian Science Reader Nora Lewis officiating.

Burial will be in the Ten Sleep Cemetery.

Oneta died Monday, November 25, 2002 at West Park Hospital in Cody.

She was born Aug. 29, 1931 in Ten Sleep to Guy and Effie Ellen (Arnold) Alexander. The family moved to Worland and lived on a farm north of town while Oneta was a child. She attended the Durkee School. She graduated from Manderson High School in 1949. She attended the Parks Business College in Denver, Colo. for a year.

Oneta returned to Worland where she worked as a secretary for the superintendent of the Holly Sugar Factory until her marriage.

On April 16, 1952, she married John W. Greet at Worland. They made their home on the Greet Ranch south of Ten Sleep on the Upper Nowood. She kept the ranch records and books for the ranching operation. She was active in the Washakie County CowBelles at one time.

She was a generous person, often helping with bereavement dinners and others in their time of need. She liked to cook and had entered baked goods in the county fair.

Her hobbies included sewing, gardening and canning produce, photography, and collecting

stamps, coins and fossils.

She was preceded in death by her parents; and a sister, Mabel Green.

Oneta is survived by her husband, John of Ten Sleep; one son, Vernon (Carol) Greet and their children Victoria, Daniel and Brandon all of Ten Sleep; one daughter, Cindy (Tom) Cromartie of El Cerrito, Calif.; and two sisters, Nora (Jerry) Lewis of Basin and Laverna Kestner of Las Cruces, N.M.
