Mary Phylemenia Peggar was born near Syracuse, New York, February 6, 1855. She moved with her parents to Missouri Valley, Iowa, in 1858 at which place she was united in marriage to James U. Hankins on October 12, 1873. With her husband she moved to Nebraska in 1884 where she lived until 1896 when she moved to Ten Sleep, Wyo, where she resided since that time. Mrs. Hankins passed away Nov. 4, 1927 at the age of 71 years, 7 months and 26 days.
