ROCK SPRINGS — Vicki Fischer Harns, a former Ten Sleep resident, died Sunday in Rock Springs. She was 26.

She was born in Milwaukee, Wisc., a daughter of Chad and Dolores (Lemke) Fischer.

On Dec. 15, 1979 she married Bill Harns in Rock Springs.

She had lived in Milwaukee until 1965 when she moved to Saukville, Wisc. After living there for a year she moved to Grafton, Wisc.

In 1971 she moved with her mother to Ten Sleep and attended schools there until 1977. She returned to Grafton for two years, then attended Northwest Community College in Powell.

She had worked as a trainer and groom at the Gault Quarter Horse Ranch at Farson. She enjoyed horses and had raced her own team in cutter races for two years.

Mrs. Harns was employed by the Get 'n Go Store in Rock Springs as the assistant manager at the time of her death. She was also a student at Western Wyoming College. Mrs. Harns was a member of the Catholic Church.

She is survived by her husband, Bill, and two sons, David and Lee, all of the family home in Rock Springs; by her parents, Shelly and Dee Schilling of Ten Sleep and Chad and Verdine Fischer of Grafton; by a brother, Mark Fischer, of Fort Collins, Colo.; and by a sister, Amy Schilling, of Ten Sleep.

The rosary will be at 7 p.m. Tuesday at the Veile Mortuary Chapel in Worland. The funeral service will be at 3 p.m. Wednesday at the Ten Sleep Methodist Church, Rev. Joseph Fraher of St. Mary Magdalen Catholic Church officiating.

Burial will be in the Ten Sleep Cemetery.

The casket will be open for viewing during the rosary and at the church in Ten Sleep from 1 to 2:45 p.m. Wednesday.
