TORRINGTON — Joint funeral services will be held for Charlotte Breeden Jacobs, 53 and her mother, Betty J. Breeden, 74. The women died of injuries sustained in an automobile accident south of Lovell. The women were on a trip visiting family and friends in the Ten Sleep area.

Charlotte Breeden Jacobs was born on July 28, 1946 at Worland, the daughter of Robert and Betty (Drake) Breeden. She attended schools in Ten Sleep and Byron; she graduated from high school at Lovell in 1965. She went on to attend the University of Wyoming, graduating from there in 1969.

She began her teaching career in Cody. She then moved to Norfolk, Va. in 1971 where she taught elementary school. She retired in 1999.

Charlotte was a member of the St. John's United Methodist Church in Norfolk; she was active in the NEST project at the church. She was a member of the United Methodist Women and the Roselin Circle. She was a member of the National Education Association.

She was preceded in death by her parents.

She is survived by her son, David Jacobs of the Naval Station in San Diego, Calif.; her daughter, Spring Jacobs of Williamsburg, Va.; and two brothers, David (Dana) of Ft. Laramie and Raymond (Susan) of Layton, Utah.

Funeral services will be Thursday, July 13 at 10 a.m. at the Ft. Laramie Presbyterian Church in Ft. Laramie with the Rev. Judith Cuthbertson officiating.
