Grace Jacobs Taffner, 86, formerly of Ten Sleep, died June 2 at Cassville, Mo.

Mrs. Taffner was born Jan. 20, 1894 at LeBette County, Kan. the daughter of Charles Robert and Corah Arledge Nicholson. She lived in Weiser, Ida. and in Nebraska before moving to the Big Trails area as a small girl.

She was raised and attended school at Big Trails.

She married Archie L. Jacobs on May 23, 1910 at Big Trails. He died on Aug. 22, 1969. She married John H. Taffner on Jan. 7, 1971 at Worland. He died on June 26, 1977.

Following her first marriage she lived in Lethbridge, Alberta, Canada from 1912 to 1915. She had lived in Ten Sleep since 1915. She was a founding member of the Ten Sleep Seventh Day Adventist Church.
