At 8:45 A. M. January 7, 1924. Julia Eliza, the lovely little daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Archie Jacobs, died at her home on Spring Creek, after a short illness of tonsilitis.

She was born April 22, 1917 at Big Trails, Wyoming, thus being only six years, eight months and sixteen days of age.

The little girl, asleep in Jesus, was buried in the Tensleep Cemetery, January 9, 1924.

The funeral services were held in Ten Sleep, amid a large concourse of friends and relatives, by the Reverend C. E. Calme, Pastor of the Methodist church.

Four beautiful and appropriate songs were sung by the Ainsworth Quartette.

Julia leaves to mourn her early passing, her parents and two sisters, Bessie age eleven and Fern a baby of two years.
