BIG TRAILS — Jack E. Jeffers, a longtime rancher, died of cancer Wednesday at Washakie Memorial Hospital in Worland. He was 67.

Jeffers was born Sept. 27, 1918 on a ranch near Dayton, a son of Hale C. and Maude M. (Hutton) Jeffers. On Sept. 1, 1939, he married Helen K. Fitzpatrick at Sheridan.

He was raised on a ranch and attended school in Dayton. After working several years at ranches in the Sheridan region, he bought his first ranch in 1940 at Decker, Mont. He moved to a ranch on Piney Creek near Lake DeSmet in 1947. Twenty years later, he and his family moved to Big Trails.

While residing at Piney Creek, he served 12 years on the Kearney School District Board of Education.

Survivors include his wife of Big Trails; a son, Jeff E. Jeffers, of Worland; and four daughters, Mrs. Jack (Karen) Dalton of Albuquerque, N.M., Mrs. Bob (Jackie) Allen of Sheridan, Mrs. Linda Jeffers of Tucson, Ariz., and Mrs. James
