William Marshall Jones, 67, of Worland died Tuesday at Washakie Memorial Hospital following his return from the Veterans Administration Hospital at Miles City, Mont., where he had been receiving treatment for emphysema. He was born Mar. 27, 1906, in Basin, the son of Charles M. and Eva Blanche Jones. The family later moved to Ten Sleep where Mr. Jones attended school.

Mr. Jones had worked for various Big Horn Basin stockmen. He was an artist, musician and skilled woodsman. He had been employed on the survey team of C.J. Atherley which conducted the original land survey in northern Wyoming.

Survivors include a brother, Charles M. Jones of Worland, and two sisters, Mrs. Frank (Millie) Bull of Worland and Mrs. Arnold (Mary) Waln of Ten Sleep. He was preceded in death by a brother, Thomas Jones, and a sister, Mrs. Jake (Sis) Goodrich.

Services will be 10 a.m. Saturday at the Ten Sleep Methodist Church with the Rev. Billy Bowden officiating. Burial will follow in the Ten Sleep Cemetery with graveside services by Floyd Minch Post No. 44, American Legion. Veile Mortuary is in charge of arrangements.
