Jones Funeral Set In Ten Sleep

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Friday in the Ten Sleep Methodist church for Thomas Lloyd Jones, 67, who died Sunday in a Minneapolis veterans hospital.

Burial will be in Ten Sleep cemetery, with Veile mortuary of Worland in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Jones was born Feb. 12, 1897, at Hyattville, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Jones. He married Mildred Kresha at Red Lodge, Mont., Aug. 6, 1937.

Except for the time spent in the armed services during World War I, Mr. Jones had been engaged in the ranching business in the Worland, Ten Sleep and Hyattville areas since 1911. He managed the Mercer Land and Livestock Co. operations at Hyattville from 1939 to 1944. The couple had made their home in Worland in later years.

Surviving are his wife, of Worland; three sisters, Mrs. Nellie Bull and Mrs. Mary Wain, both of Ten Sleep, and Mrs. Blanche Goodrich of Manderson, and two brothers, Charles of Casper and Bill of Worland.

A memorial fund has been established to be contributed to the Cancer fund.
