Roger Albert Jordan, 74, died Aug. 15 in Shelton, Wash.

He was born in Lead, S.D., in 1907 to Albert and Rose Jordan. In his early teens he settled in the Casper area where he worked as a cowboy and ranch hand. During World War II he worked in the shipyards in Washington state. He was later employed at the Wyoming Industrial Institute near Worland.

After his retirement he and his wife, Irene, moved to Ten Sleep and managed the Flagstaff Motel for several years.

He was a member of the Kiwanis and Lions Clubs in Shelton and the Elks Lodge in Worland.

He married Irene McCann in Casper in 1935. Two children were born to the couple, Donna Rae and Roy Allen. Irene died in 1979.

He later married Helen Savage of Shelton, Wash., and made his home there until his death.

Survivors include his widow, son and daughter, five grandchildren, one great-granddaughter and one sister, Marie Thompson of Oklahoma.

Memorial service will be at 11 a.m. Aug. 21 at the Ten Sleep Methodist Chapel with Rev. Estes officiating.
