### Rose E. Lamb

WORLAND — Rose E. Lamb, 75, of Worland, died Tuesday, Dec. 17, in Washakie Memorial Hospital.

She was born Oct. 11, 1916, in Longmont, Colo., a daughter of Joseph F. and Barbara M. (Gross) Salzman. She moved to Worland with her parents in 1917, and attended schools at South Flat and Durkee, then graduated from Washakie County High School in 1935.

On Aug. 30, 1937, she married Martin P. Lamb in Worland. He died July 4, 1978.

She worked as a nurses' aide for several years at Washakie Memorial Hospital. She and her husband lived in Volberg, Mont. and in Ten Sleep for a brief period, but she lived in Worland for most of her life.

Mrs. Lamb was a member of St. Mary Magdalen Catholic Church, where she was active in C.C.W. She was a member of the Worland TOPS and the Washakie Memorial Hospi-

tal Auxiliary. Her hobbies included reading and needlework.

Survivors include one foster son, John Salzman of Worland; one daughter, Mary Jo McDermott of Fort Collins, Colo.; one brother, Pete Salzman of Worland; two sisters, Lena Ogg and Anne Piel, both of Worland; four grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by one son, Martin Daniel Lamb, four brothers and two sisters.

The rosary service is scheduled for 7 p.m. Thursday in the St. Mary Magdalen Catholic Church. Mass of the Resurrection will be held at 10 a.m. Friday in the church, with the Rev. Thomas Ogg and the Rev. Richard MacLellan officiating. Burial will be at 11:45 a.m. in Ten Sleep Cemetery.
