Mrs. Lamb Dies In Hospital

Funeral services are scheduled at 2 p.m. Thursday in Veile chapel for Mrs. Mary Elizabeth Lamb, 86, a resident of Worland since 1917, who died Tuesday in Washakie Memorial hospital.

The Rev. William Duay will officiate at services. Burial will be in Ten Sleep cemetery. Veile mortuary is in charge of arrangements.

Mrs. Lamb was born Oct. 1, 1882, in Clifton, Idaho, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Merideth B. Merideth. The family lived at Fort Washakie and she attended school at Lander.

In June, 1907, she was married to Porter Lamb at Lander. The couple moved to Spring Creek in April, 1909, and came to Worland in 1917. Mr. Lamb died Sept. 8, 1938.

Mrs. Lamb was a member of Washakie County Historical society.

She is survived by one son, Martin, of Worland; one daughter, Mrs. Margaret Fisher of Golden, Colo.; one sister, Mrs. Dora Decker of Lander; one brother, John Merideth of Riverton and three grandchildren.
