Harold Lewis, 38, died from injuries received in a truck accident early Thursday morning, east of Casper on Interstate 25.

He was born Oct. 22, 1932 in Ten Sleep. He graduated from Ten Sleep High School and moved to Spokane, Wash., until moving to Casper in 1961. He was employed as a mechanic for the Coleman Welding Service of Casper.
