### Mae Lewis

Mae Lewis died Sunday, April 23 at the Wyoming Retirement Center in Basin. She was 92.

She was born May 31, 1896 in Punxsutawney, Penn., a daughter of Harvey and Etta L. (Bruner) Sheesley. She was raised at Punxsutawney and attended Clarion Normal School at Clarion, Penn.

She taught school for a couple years before she and her brother, Maurice Sheesley moved to Wyoming. They settled in the Lower No-wood area near Ten Sleep and she taught school for two years.

On June 20, 1921 she married Perle M. Lewis at Punxsutawney, Penn. Following her marriage, the couple moved to Steamboat Springs, Colo. In 1924 they moved to Midwest and in 1927 back to Ten Sleep.

After her husband died in 1954, she moved to Basin and lived there until 1960 when she moved to Worland.

She was a member of the United

Methodist Church, the Worland Senior Citizens and had belonged to the Worland Women's Club.

In 1985 she moved to the Pioneer Home and in December 1986 to the Wyoming Retirement Center in Basin.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Harry (Dorthea) Kenagy of Worland and Norma Yoos of Casper; one brother, Ira Sheesley of Orange Park, Fla.; one sister, Blanche Domb of Lakeland, Fla.; five grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren.

The service is scheduled for 1 p.m. Thursday at the United Methodist Church in Worland with the Rev. Richard Stormont officiating. Burial will be at 3 p.m. at the Ten Sleep Cemetery.
