Lindley Rites Slated Today

Funeral services will be conducted at 1 p.m. Saturday in Velle chapel here for Leonard (Jeff) Lindley, 53, long-time Worland resident. Mr. Lindley died Wednesday of a heart attack, 16 miles west of Green River, where he was labor foreman for Big Horn Construction Co. on a construction job.

The Rev. Louis Haruf will officiate at services. Burial will be in Ten Sleep cemetery, with the Rev. Howard Kildow officiating at committal services. Velle mortuary is in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Lindley was born Dec. 16, 1913, in Electra, Texas, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Ernest E. Lindley. He married Sadie Fish at Worland on Aug. 10, 1935.

He had been a resident of Worland for 32 years, being employed by Ray Bower and the city of Worland. For the past year he had lived in Green River, where he was a labor foreman for Big Horn Construction Co.

Surviving are his wife; one son, Gordon E. Lindley of Worland; two sisters, Mrs. Linnie Morris of Amarillo, Texas, and Mrs. Jack (Gladys) Copeland of Farmington, N.M., and one brother, Ernest E. Lindley of Portland, Ore.
