Funeral services for George R. MacDonald, 50, who died Sunday of a heart attack at the Washakie Memorial hospital, will be Wednesday at 10:30 a.m. at the Ten Sleep LDS Church.

He was born March 15, 1925, the son of David D. and Grace M. MacDonald, in Milton, Mass., where he received his education. He served with the Army Air Corps in World War II and with the U.S. Air Force during the Korean conflict. He had worked as a printer all his working years. He worked for the Northern Wyoming DAILY NEWS as a printer since 1971.

MacDonald married Gretchen Balduf Dec. 1, 1951 at Norwood, Mass. The couple moved to Ten Sleep in 1971 where they purchased the Wyoming Cafe.

Survivors include his widow; his mother, of Cocoa, Fla.; three sons, George R. MacDonald, Jr., Jeffery City, and Mark and David MacDonald, both of Ten Sleep; one daughter, Kathleen MacDonald of Grantsville, Utah; and one sister, Mrs. Lester (Grace) Badger of Cocoa, Fla.
