Iris Maria McCreery, 65, a native of the Big Horn Basin, died in the West Park Hospital emergency room in Cody on Tuesday May 21, 1991.

Mrs. McCreery was born Jan. 22, 1926 at Manderson, the daughter of Virgil Oscar and Myrtle Morgan Beaver. She grew up in and attended school at Manderson. In 1942, she married James Ogg. They were divorced in 1966, and she later married Leo "Pete" McCreery.

Mrs. McCreery was a member of the Manderson Church until six years ago, when she transferred her membership to Grace Baptist Church of Greybull.

She was a member of the VFW Auxiliary of Greybull and the Eagles Auxiliary of Basin. Except for nine years, she lived all her life in the Big Horn Basin.

She was preceded in death by her parents.
