**INQUEST INTO DEATH OF TEN
SLEEP MAN SET FOR TONIGHT**

BUFFALO, May 29 — (U.P.) — Johnson county coroner William Adams Thursday scheduled an inquest into the death of Clinton McCreery, 37, of Ten Sleep, for Friday night.
Adams said McCreery was killed

when he "fell or jumped" from a pickup truck he was driving on a country road south of Arvada, Wednesday night.

worker who was riding with McCreery at the time of the accident, was being held on an open charge at the Johnson county jail here pending the inquest.

Adams declined to comment on circumstances surrounding the death. He said the jury would decide how the accident happened.

The coroner and a sheriff's deputy were on the scene of the accident most of Thursday picking up details of the accident.

The coroner said both men apparently had been drinking at the time. McCreery was killed when he fell out the door on the driver's side and the vehicle's wheels passed over his head.
