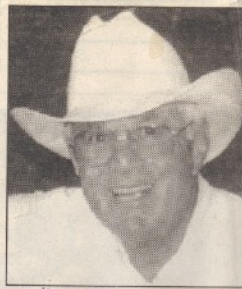

TEN SLEEP — Funeral services for Dale Allen McGarvin, 66, of Ten Sleep will be held Monday, Feb. 17 at 2 p.m. at the Zion Lutheran Church in Worland with the Rev. L.E. "Bud" Surles officiating.

Burial will follow at 4 p.m. at the Ten Sleep Cemetery with the Rev. Chuck Cooper officiating. A reception will follow the burial at the Ten Sleep Methodist Church.

Dale died Thursday, February 13, 2003 at his home east of Ten Sleep after a courageous battle with a brain tumor.

He was born May 8, 1936 on the family farm south of Worland to Gordon E. and D. Vivian (Kennedy) McGarvin. He attended schools in Worland and graduated from Washakie County High School in 1954. While in high school, he worked for a grocery store and was active in football and 4-H.

On April 8, 1956, he married Mary Ann Klein at Loveland, Colo. They were later divorced.

He then worked for Alex's Foodland and for Mobil Oil Co. before he joined his father and his cousin, Ralph Wortham, in their excavating company. In 1958, Dale and his father started their own construction company, McGarvin Construction. In 1963, Harry Moberly joined Dale and the very successful company was renamed McGarvin-Moberly Construction. It is a major highway construction and paving company in Wyoming. Dale retired in 1991.

Dale married Terry L. Jones on May 21, 1993 at Ten Sleep.

Dale served as a Washakie County Commissioner from 1970-1978. He was a partner in the ownership of the Stockgrowers State Bank and served on the bank's board of directors until his death.

Dale was a member of the

Masonic Lodge, Shriners, Worland Elks Lodge, the Ten Sleep/Hyattville Lions Club, Worland Country Club, Wyoming Associated General Contractors, Ten Sleep Rodeo Club, Big Horn SnoGoers, Cowboy Joe Club and Zion Lutheran Church.

Dale loved to hunt, fish, golf, fly his own airplane, snowmobile, travel in his motorhome, and be outdoors. Dale loved living in his home in Ten Sleep Canyon and living in the Coachella Valley of southern California in the winters.

He was preceded in death by his father, and a sister, Ruth Joanne Monahan.

Dale is survived by his wife, Terry McGarvin of Ten Sleep; his mother, Vivian Stroud of Worland; three sons, David (Wendy) McGarvin and James (Roxie) McGarvin all of Ten Sleep and Mark (Donna) McGarvin of Worland; a stepson, Matt (Heather) Jones of Great Falls, Mont.; one daughter, Jeanne Ann (John) Scott of Longmont, Colo.; two stepdaughters, Carla (Kyle) Dunham of Evergreen, Colo. and Miranda Jones of Butte, Mont.; two brothers, Lyle (Gladys) McGarvin and Larry (Sue) McGarvin all of Ten Sleep; one sister, Jeanette (Darrell) Schneider of Worland; and 13 grandchildren, Brittany, Breanna, Jan, Justin, Jeren, Jacob, Danse, Calc, Shania, Guy, Marli, Hailey and Bode.
