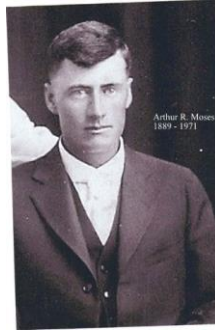


Arthur R. Moses

BUFFALO — Arthur R. Moses, 82, of Buffalo, formerly of Ten Sleep, died Friday at Johnson County Memorial Hospital. He was born Aug. 23, 1889, in Lebo, Kan. He moved to the Big Horn Basin in 1890 with his family who homesteaded in Ten Sleep. He married Edna Jacobs in Worland in 1919.

He was a veteran of World War I and had worked as a logger in the Big Horn Mountains most of his life.

Survivors include the widow of Buffalo; sons, Arthur L. Moses of Buffalo and Archie Moses of Arlington, Tex.; a brother, Dewey Moses of Buffalo; sisters, Mrs. Jane Prevo of Worland and Mrs. Edna Black of Glendale, Calif.; a half-sister, Mrs. Mary Smith of Everett, Wash.; and four grandchildren. He was preceded in death by a daughter, two brothers and a sister.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Monday at the Ten Sleep Seventh-day Adventist Church followed by burial in the Ten Sleep Cemetery with military graveside rites by the American Legion.
