Edna Ruth Moses, 90, died Sunday, May 5, at the Wyoming Retirement Center at Basin.

She was born Sept. 22, 1894 in Hay Springs, Neb., to Lewis Murray and Estella (Gaskill) Jacobs. On June 21, 1919, she married Arthur Richard Moses at Worland.

She moved with her parents in a covered wagon to the Spring Creek area south of Ten Sleep in 1899. She was raised and schooled at the Spring Creek School. Following her marriage she lived in Ten Sleep until 1970 when she moved to Buffalo. She entered the Wyoming Soldiers and Sailor Home in 1972 and went to the Wyoming State Retirement Center in Basin in 1977. She had been an active member in the Ten Sleep Seventh Day Adventist Church.

She was preceded in death by her husband in 1971 and one daughter,

Irene, in 1964.

Survivors two sons Arthur L. "Buster" Moses of Lava Hot Springs, Idaho, and Archie G. "Bud" Moses of Arlington, Texas; one brother, Earl Jacobs of Ycaipa, Calif.; nine grandchildren; and many great-grandchildren.

The funeral service will be at 2 p.m., Friday, May 10 at the Seventh Day Adventist Church in Ten Sleep with the Rev. Paul Vercio officiating. Burial will be in the Ten Sleep Cemetery. Veile Mortuary is in charge of the arrangements.

Edna Ruth Jacobs was born September 22, 1894, in Hay Springs, NE, to Lewis M. and Stella Gaskill Jacobs. When she was yet under age, the family moved to the area of Ten Sleep, WY and, for the most part, she resided in Ten Sleep all her days. She married Arthur Richard Moses on June 24, 1919, in Worland, WY. The couple had three children: Irene L Moses Ilg, Arthur Lewis Moses, and Archibald George Moses. Her two sons served in the military: Arthur in Germany and Archie in the Air Force. Her sons were gifted musicians and vocalists. She was a member of the Seventh-Day Adventist Church and practiced that faith all of her life. She spent the last years of her life in the Old Soldiers & Sailor's Home at Basin, WY. Edna passed away May 5, 1985 in Basin, WY. She was preceded in death by her husband Arthur and her daughter Irene. Edna was gentle in all of her relationships and a credit to her parents and to her posterity.
