

EDGAR MULHERIN

1899-1950



Edgar Mulherin was born in Absaroka, MT 10 September 1899. His mother was Martha Mulherin who lived intermittently in Ten Sleep, WY, but not continuouslyⁱ. “Ed” had brothers Frank, Roy, Joe and Preston plus sisters Mrs. Gussie King, Mrs. Martha Aunes, Mrs Sue Taylor and Mrs. Edna Buckmaster (Wife of Mike Buckmaster). He married Laura Wymanⁱⁱ, daughter of Charles Wyman, Sr. in 1917. The couple ranched in the area particularly on the Wyman holdings. He died in San Francisco, 3 October 1950. He had been unwell for some time. They had no children.ⁱⁱⁱ

Edgar Mulherin Claimed by Death

Edgar Mulherin, husband of Mrs. Laurie Wyman Mulherin, a former resident of Ten Sleep, died at San Francisco, Tuesday after an extended illness.

Mulherin was a well known stockman in the Ten Sleep area and resided there for 33 years.

He was born at Absonka, Mont., Sept. 10, 1899.

He is survived by his widow; his mother, Mrs. Martha Mulherin of Ten Sleep; four brothers, Frank of San Lorenzo, Calif., Joe of Hayward, Calif., Roy of Oceanside, Calif., Preston of Worland, and four sisters, Mrs. Gussie King of San Leandro, Calif., Mrs. Martha Miller, Oceanside, Calif., Mrs. Sue Taylor, California, and Mrs. Edna Buckmaster, Worland.

Funeral services will be held Monday at 2 p.m. at Ten Sleep with the Rev. R. F. Goff of Worland officiating.

Burial will be in the Ten Sleep cemetery under the direction of the Veile mortuary of Worland.
