CHILD DIES OF SUFFOCATION IN BED CLOTHES

Lana Marie Mulholland, seven-month-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Gerald W. Mulholland of Worland, died sometime Wednesday night from suffocation in the bed clothes, coroner Arnold Velle said Thursday.

Velle said the Mulhollands discovered the suffocated infant upon arising Thursday morning and rushed her to the hospital. Resuscitation and other attempts to revive her failed, however.

The coroner said the infant girl

died of suffocation in bed clothes wedged between a railing on the bunk bed and the mattress. He added that no inquest will be held.

Funeral arrangements are pending. Lana Marie was born Nov. 6, 1952, in Worland.
